General Information

The 35th European Coaches' Conference will be held at the Tali Tennis Centre in Helsinki, Finland, from 24-28 October.

Programme

The conference programme will focus on topics including teaching methodology, conditioning and tactical development.

The complete programme and a full list of speakers due to appear at the event will be published at the end of June.

Participants

The conference is open to a maximum of two delegates from each of Tennis Europe's member nations. All participants should be involved as persons in charge of the National Junior/Professional or Coaches Education Programmes.

All participants must be approved and nominated by their National Association. Tennis Europe shall not accept direct entries from private persons or other organisations. Speakers making a presentation at the conference will not be counted towards their country's quota.

ITF/Tennis Europe Development Programme

The ITF/Tennis Europe Development Programme supports the 2012 Coaches' Conference. Delegates representing countries that benefit from the Development Programme are invited to attend an additional 1-day session, to be held on Sunday 28th October. Departure day for these delegates will therefore be Monday 29th October.

Accommodation can only be offered to participants from member nations that are part of the ITF/Tennis Europe Development Programme. All interested nations must enter their representative using the <u>online form</u>. The deadline for requesting the accommodation grant is <u>Friday 8th June</u>.

Receipt of the grant is subject to the following conditions:

- · Representatives nominated by national federations must work closely with the federation in the areas of tennis participation/coaches education (i.e. National Junior Tennis Initiative Coordinator, Director/Administrator of Coaching/Coaches Education, etc.).
- · He/She has a reasonable level of English in order to be able to follow the conference.
- · He/She is able to report to the other coaches in his/her country about the contents of the conference.
